Numeracy and Maths

In Term 1, we will

- Explore addition and subtraction strategies
- Learn skip counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Identifying 2d shapes and learning properties of these.
- Looking at data and answering questions about it.
- Doubling numbers and multiplying by 2.
- Place value up to 100 and 1000.
- Halves of shapes and symmetry



You can support this at home by:

- Completing home learning tasks on Showbie.
- Practising counting forwards and backwards in 1s 2s 5s and 10s at home.
- Looking for 2d shapes in the environment or out on a walk.
- Practising numbers bonds to 10 and linking to bonds to 100. Eg.
 $1+9 = 10$ $10 + 90 = 100$

Literacy

This term in **Literacy** we will be exploring:

- New sounds each week
- Weekly reading books
- Sentence writing with a focus on tools for writing (capital letters, full stops, sounding out words.) and recount writing
- Answering questions about a story we have read or heard.



You can support this at home by:

- On a daily basis, practice reading newspapers, comics, books (fiction or non-fiction or magazines).
- Practise talking and listening skills. You could time each other to see who can talk the longest about a subject.
- Access the home learning posted weekly on Showbie.
- Opportunities for writing eg. helping write the shopping list or writing a card to a friend.
- Play literacy games on topmarks.co.uk

Other Curricular Areas

Our Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL) will focus on Victorian Glasgow and children will compare their lives today to how life was then. In STEM we will look at the rotation of the Earth, the orbit and the phases of the Moon and look at living and non-living things and food chains.

In RME we will look at Christian Bible stories and how this shows Christian beliefs. We will talk about our own beliefs and compare these to Christian beliefs.

In Expressive Arts we will explore creating art in a range of mediums using printing, painting and textures. We will explore different artists and enjoy art linked to our learning across the curriculum.

Health and Wellbeing

P2/3 have PE on a Tuesday (indoor) and a Thursday (indoor)

In P.E. we will be focussing on our core skills and movement. We will also look at working with others and improving our listening.

Please ensure your child has their full P.E. kit, including footwear, on these days. **All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons.**

Staff are not allowed to remove earrings so if your child cannot take these out then please take them out before coming to school.

We use our daily emotions check-in to express our feelings throughout the day. We will continue to explore these through two PATHS lessons each week. Our PATHS lessons this term will focus on reviewing all emotions and managing our uncomfortable feelings.

- Dress sensibly for outdoor learning as we will be going outside in almost all conditions.
