


P7 TERM 3 2026 OVERVIEW



Numeracy and Maths

In Term 3, we will continue to revise learned strategies to ensure we are confident in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will also be focussing on fractions, decimals, percentages, compass points and angles. Some key phrases we will be using are:

- Acute, obtuse, right, straight, complimentary and supplementary
- North, South, East, West, North East, South East, South West and North West.
- Equivalent, simplify, convert



You can support this at home by:

- Reinforcing knowledge of multiplication and division facts by challenging your learner to recite them. You can do this by playing games online like Hitthebutton or using household items/playing cards to do multiples and division facts.
- Play a game of angle spotting at home or out an about. Who can find the most acute angles? Who can find an obtuse angle?



Partition

Literacy

This term in **Literacy** we will be exploring:

- Persuasive writing
- Spelling rules and patterns
- New words and phrases
- Identifying meaning
- Generating evaluations
- Increasing our range of punctuation



You can support this at home by:

- Look at examples of persuasion in the media and on TV (think adverts or persuasive texts encouraging the reader to do something/change their mind).
- Explore new words in the environment, on TV and in the media. Can you guess the meaning of the word using its context? Look up the meaning of the word and try to use it to create as many sentences as you can.
- Take time to look at your child's spelling words for the week and support them in learning these and their patterns.

Other Curricular Areas

In IDL, we are learning about Scottish Inventors and their inventions. We will then be moving onto study an element of our local community with the intention of bringing about positive change in some way (led by the children).

In P.E we are continuing to attend The Gorbals for swimming and fitness. We will soon begin Athletics and Golf.

In Science, we are learning about body systems with Mrs Lovick and we will be taking part in Fun STEM with our friends at Eastbank Academy and EDT. This is a sustainability engineering challenge.
