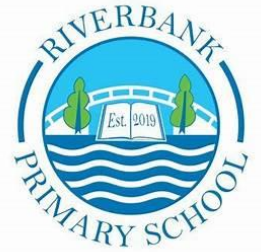


# P7 TERM 4 2026 OVERVIEW



## Numeracy and Maths

In Term 4, we will continue to revise learned strategies to ensure we are confident in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will also be learning about data, time and numeracy within the wider world/world of work. Some key phrases we will be using are:

- Timetable, durations, periods
- Graph, ascending, descending, trends, data, survey
- Data analysis, profit, loss, trends



You can support this at home by:

- Encouraging your child to explore real life time situations. Can they plan a timetable for your weekend plans? Can they calculate the duration of time a programme will be on for?
- Can you explore real graphs in the real world? Can they analyse the graph and read the data effectively?
- Talk to your child about how YOU use maths to run your household. Share how you budget. Share how you manage money when paying bills and going shopping.

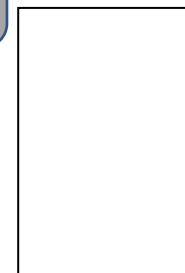
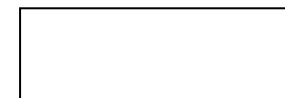
Partition

## Literacy

This term in **Literacy** we will be exploring:

- Discursive writing
- Spelling rules and patterns
- New words and phrases
- Researching for relevant information
- Identifying fact and opinion
- Increasing our expression while reading



You can support this at home by:

- Encouraging your child to read aloud, to you or to others.
- Give your child a mini project and ask them to research and gather information on the topic to feedback to you.
- Play a game of 2 truths and a lie. Can your child identify the fact from the fiction?

## Other Curricular Areas

In IDL, we are learning about the Commonwealth Games and the participating countries. We will study the geography, languages, history religion and culture of the countries and collect information to present in an ebook. We will also be working towards presenting the best Leavers Assembly EVER!

In P.E we are learning to increase accuracy and speed in striking and fielding.

In Science, we are continuing to learn about body systems with Mrs Lovick.
