

P1 TERM 1 2024 OVERVIEW




Numeracy and Maths

In Term 1, we will be introducing numbers 0-10. We will be working on the number names, formation, sequencing and counting amounts.

We will also be focussing on 2d shape in maths. Some key phrases we will be using are:

- square
- circle
- triangle
- rectangle



You can support this at home by:

- Number 0-10 formation practise
- Have a look around the house or when out on a walk for 2d shapes.
- Counting out amounts at home "can you show me 4 socks?" etc
- Number ordering from 0-10. Make little number cards and get the child to put them in the correct order.

Literacy

This term in **Literacy** we will be exploring:

- Single sounds - **a t s p i n**
- Retelling a story
- Letter formation and name writing
- Mark making
- Giving writing a go



You can support this at home by:

- Jolly phonics sounds - songs and actions.

- Reading and talking about stories together - what does an author and illustrator do? Who is the main character? Did you like that story? Why?
- Encourage as much mark making as you can. Using pencils, crayons, pens. Encourage children to give writing a go. Discuss the lines - curved, straight, zigzag
- Recognising and writing their name.

Other Curricular Areas

Primary 1 learn through play experiences in the classroom and open area. In the open area, we have the creative station, role play, construction and STEM.

We are focusing on paints and printing in the creative area. At role play, we have a zoo set up and at STEM we are exploring different textures and investigating what items will float or sink. We are building schools, classrooms and playgrounds at construction.

In IDL, we have been exploring Our School. We have met some of the important people in the building and we will continue to familiarise ourselves with the different parts of the school.

Every second Wednesday we are joined in class by Mrs S who takes the class for music. We are exploring different beats and instruments.

Health and Wellbeing



P1b have PE on a Monday (with Miss Gamble) outside and a Wednesday (with Ms Jarett) in the gym hall.

In P.E. we will familiarise ourselves with the routine and expectations during PE, taking great care about how we move our bodies. We will introduce our core skills of throwing and catching, running and team games.

Please ensure your child has their full P.E. kit, including footwear, on these days. Some of the sessions will be on the pitch. **All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons. Staff are not allowed to remove earrings so if your child cannot take these out then please take them out before coming to school.**

We use our daily emotions check-in to express our feelings throughout the day. We will continue to explore these through two PATHS lessons each week. Our PATHS lesson this term will help us manage our emotions and we will begin to explore the idea of giving and receiving compliments.
