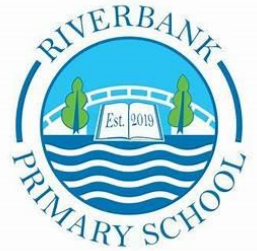

Numeracy:

- Numbers to 10 - counting and formation
- Number ordering, sequences and patterns
- Number facts and Number bonds to 10

Maths:

- 2D and 3D shape
- Pattern
