Literacy

This term in <u>Literacy</u> we will be:

- Focusing on rhyme and nursery rhymes
- Learning our initial sounds a t s p i n
- Starting to read, write and make 3 letter words using the above sounds (cvc words e.g., sat)
- Writing and recognising our names.

- Continue to work on writing and recognising your name.
- Work on pencil grip when mark making straight, diagonal and curved lines

Other Curricular Areas

In Primary 1, we learn through play-based learning. The classroom and open area are set up to invite and encourage children to explore, create and work together. We have construction resources such as blocks, animals and magnetic tiles. There is a library space where books are rotated regularly so children can experience different authors and styles. During Term 1, fine motor activities are available to support pencil control and grip. Every second Wednesday we will be joined by Mrs S for music.
