

# P1/2 TERM 1 2025



## Numeracy and Maths

For Numeracy this term we will be focussing on number recognition and counting skills. For P1, we will be introducing numbers up to 10 and working on different ways to show this number, eg, counting out objects, showing the number on a ten frame and practising writing the numerals. For P2, we will be revising numbers to 20 and practising our counting skills, including working on number bonds to 20 and finding the missing numbers on a number line.



You can support this at home by:

- Counting objects at home and when out and about, for example counting cars on the road, toys in the toy box, etc.
- Looking for numbers when in our environment, for example numbers on a bus, numbers on a TV remote, etc.
- Topmarks.co.uk has some great number recognition and counting games, including Teddy Numbers, Underwater Counting and Ladybird Spots games.

#### Literacy

This term in Literacy we will be:

- Exploring weekly letter sounds
- Learning to recognise weekly common words
- Continuing to use our tools for writing skills across our learning

- Look out for words in your environment Do you recognise any of the letter sounds?
- Read stories at home and discuss it together Who is your favourite character? What was your favourite part of the story? Did the story have a happy ending?
- Work on writing your name what letter sounds are in your name?

#### Other Curricular Areas

In IDL, we are going to be exploring many of our favourite fairytales through our challenge to create our own Fairyland. We will be using our imaginations, reading lots of our favourite stories and working together to solve many problems that the fairytale characters have – Can we grow a new beanstalk for Jack? Can we build a strong house for the 3 Little Pigs? Can we design a map to help Little Red Riding Hood get straight to Grandma's House? Through these challenges, we will have lots of opportunity to design, use problem solving skills and be creative. We can't wait to bring Fairyland to life here in Riverbank!

### Health and Wellbeing

Pla have PE on a Monday (indoor with Miss Stewart) and a Friday (indoor with Miss Stewart).

In P.E. we will be focusing on Scottish Country Dancing and developing our core skills. We will be working in teams and encouraging our friends through our activities.

Please ensure your child has their full P.E. kit, including footwear, on these days. Some of the sessions will be on the pitch. All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons. Staff are not allowed to remove earrings so if your child cannot take these out then please take them out before coming to school.

We use our daily emotions check-in to express our feelings throughout the day. We will continue to explore these through two PATHS lessons each week. We will be choosing a PATHS Pupil of the Day who will receive compliments daily from their classmates.

We will be looking at our similarities and differences and how we are all unique through exploring different stories and having class discussions.
