## Numeracy and Maths

In Term 1, we will be revising and expanding our knowledge of place value, we will be working with numbers up to 1000 and working on rounding and estimation within this. We will then be working on addition and subtraction.

We will be working on our 2D shape identification and creating shapes physically and on the iPads. We will also look at lines of symmetry. We will also be looking at coordinates.

We will work on our skip counting weekly and working on our multiplication also, aiming to practice both everyday as a warmup to our lessons.

We are using money within our class economy, exchanging and totalling our tables total income each week.

In science with Miss Lovick we will be looking at animal and plant classification and will be carrying out experiments with growing plants.


### Health and Wellbeing
