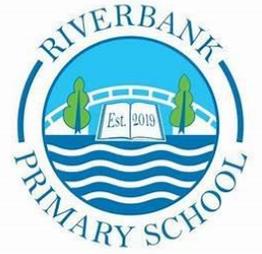




P2 TERM 3 2025



Numeracy and Maths

In Term 3, we will be Multiplication and Division

P.2 will be looking at different strategies to solve multiplication and division problems, focussing on the 2- and 4-times tables. This will involve using lots of concrete resources to share and create equal groups to help us solve our problems through repeated addition/subtraction alongside creating arrays.

Furthermore, we will be looking at skip counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

In maths we will be learning about fractions and money.

Literacy

This term in **Literacy** we will be:

- Using our knowledge of sounds to read and spell words
- Continuing to use our tools for writing skills across our learning
- Focusing on recount writing



You can support this at home by:

- Please see Showbie for the weekly home learning sheet
- Encourage your children at the end of the day to tell you what has happened, in order, encouraging language such as "first", "next", "after that", "finally".
- 10 minutes reading per night can have a great impact on your child's ability to remember sight words and become a fluent reader.
- Encourage your child to read for enjoyment.
- Encourage your child to make up stories and write them in a notebook.

Other Curricular Areas

In IDL, we are going to be covering Scottish Myths and Legends for 6 weeks and then we will progress to cover our Local Area and the wildlife within it.

We use our daily emotions check-in to express our feelings throughout the day. We will continue to explore these through two PATHS lessons each week.
