## Numeracy and Maths

### Welcome to Numeracy in P1.

In Term 3, we will be looking at:

#### Numeracy:

- Numbers to 30 - counting and formation
- Number ordering, sequences and patterns
- Double numbers and number bonds to 10
- Addition and subtraction strategies
- Skip counting - 2s, 5s and 10s.

#### Maths:

- Revision of 2D and 3D shape
- Time - daily routines, o'clock and half past
- Money - Coin values and totals to 20p
- Position & Movement

- Counting forwards and backwards regularly
- Giving your child numbers to write and count within 30
- Regular formation practice of all numbers to 30
- Using household objects to count (5 bits of pasta, 8 toys etc)

## Literacy

### Literacy

This term in Literacy we will be:

- Phonics - v, j, q(u), x, z, y and revising all other single letter sounds previously taught.
- Reading books - beginning to answer comprehension and true/false style questioning based on the text.
- Blending - reading and writing simple CVC words
- Consonant blends (fr, bl, fl)
- Sentence writing - using a word bank and beginning to generate own ideas to create sentences. Continuing to focus on our Tools for writing strategies.

- Consistently practise the sounds shared on Showbie
- Continue to work on writing and recognising your name.
- Reading or listening to a story as often as you can.

### Other Curricular Areas

In Primary 1, we learn through play-based learning. The classroom and open area are set up to invite and encourage children to explore, create and work together. We have a role play area set up as a hairdresser, and it will change and develop based on the children's ideas and interests. The water play area provides children with an engaging environment to explore sensory play, develop motor skills and build social connections. The construction area gives children a hands-on space to develop problem solving and motor skills. Every second Wednesday we will continue to be joined by Mrs S for music.
