Literacy

This term in reading we will be exploring:

 Non-fiction in our reading through news lessons which are adapted from articles which have appeared in the media. We will be building on the reading strategies developed over Terms 1 and 2 to deepen understanding of texts.

In writing we will learn about writing a short autobiography and keeping a diary through our IDL topic. The class will also have the opportunity to write a discussion piece based on some of the issues in our IDL topic on migration.

Numeracy and Maths

In Term 3, we will continue to revise learned strategies to ensure we are confident in addition and subtraction before we move on to multiplication and division.

We will also be focussing on 2 and 3D shape, angles and time.

Some key phrases we will be using are:

- faces, vertices, sides
- acute, right, straight, obtuse and reflex
- seconds, minutes, hours, days...

Health and Wellbeing

In PE, we will be focussing on:

- Scottish Country Dancing
- Target Games

We use our daily emotional check in to express our feelings throughout the day. We will continue to explore these through 2 x PATHs lessons. All jewellery should be removed on PE days.
